Role Summary:	Support the Bushcraft Skills Lead / Co-ordinator in the delivery of the Bushcraft Skills activity area for young people and adult participants to make the Jamboree a success.
Key Responsibilities:	<p>As part of the Bushcraft Skills zone (onsite day), we will be delivering a wide range of activities (e.g. fire, food and tools including knives and axes). We are looking for staff support from keen, enthusiastic leaders who like to have fun and rise to a challenge. More information:	<p>The onsite day program is one of 6 activity days that will be running as part of BrumJam 2020. Participants of the camp will be able to choose from a wide range of activities within the Bushcraft area for the duration of their time within the zone, there will be different groups throughout the day in the zone. For 2020, Bushcraft is being led by a team from Birmingham County Scouts, we require staff to help deliver these activities and are looking for people to assist with the setup and delivery of the zone as highlighted above. Any prior knowledge within the Bushcraft area will be helpful, but not essential, but you will need to bring along a desire to learn, be challenged and be supportive at all times.</p>
